

Emmanuel Fricero came into this world to become a director.

Born on the 6th of November 1981 on the French Riviera, he quickly finds his own way. From the age of eight, he is irresistibly attracted by the camera of his parents and makes his first experiences by directing his younger brother as well as several other members of his family for some films, which get edited via video-tape recorder. At the same time, the young cineaste meets friends of his brother, with whom he makes several experiences behind and in front of the camera. These experiences have one effect: confirm his deep desire to become a director.

After having obtained his baccalauréat in economics (equivalent of A-levels), he integrates the « Ecole Supérieure de Réalisation Audiovisuelle" (superior school of audio-visual arts directing) of Nice in 2001. **Emmanuel Fricero** uses the opportunity to improve his know-how and elaborates more and more ambitious projects. Awarding his diploma 2004, he creates the collective noun **Fricero Films** which will get officialised as an association in 2006.

Aged 27, the young director presents you his most perfected work today: La Dernière Leçon du Parrain (The Godfather's Last Lesson).

- 117 different persons listed in the credits,
- **50 extras** in the restaurant « Le Ligure » in Nice (France) during the 4th shooting day,
- 35 cubic meters of stuff, put away into 2 rental vans,
- 30 meters of rails for tracking shots,
- 1 panther, 1 snake, 1 mini Jib, 1 car grip for the picture recording,
- 1 car and fuel barrel **explosion**, 1 **explosive device** with an artillery shell effect,
- 2 BMW, 1 Ferrari as well as 2 4x4, 1 motorbike and 1 quad bike,
- 1 car pursuit in Drap (France), on a road section specially blocked for this purpose by a municipal edict,
- More than 20 blank handguns, 2 machine pistols, 1 crossbow,
 1 blank sporting gun and 1 rocket launcher,
- 623 (blank) bullets shot,
- 15 screen deaths,
- 514 shots in the film,
- 111 numerically reworked shots.

Summary:

1382, in France: Louis 1st of Anjou and Charles de Duras are leading a particularly cruel war against each other to conquer the kingdom of Naples and of Provence. After months of battles, none of both manages to get the lordship. Finally, Nice is placed under the control of the earl of Savoy, Amédée VII. Humiliated and grieved, Charles de Duras, called "the Murderer", starts to track those who he thinks are responsible for his failure: the deserters among his soldiers. But his thirst for revenge and his taste for blood will progressively lead him to face his own demons. Haunted by a recurring nightmare, he tries to find a sense for this name that echoes in his memory: « Alcalia ».






